

Subject: Important about your WhizRider

Dear smartridr Customer,

Our information shows that you purchased a product named WhizRider – Portable Car Seat Option.

The definition of Child Restraint System in U.S. Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) No. 213, Child Restraint Systems is:

“Child restraint system means any device, except Type I or Type II seat belts, designed for use in a motor vehicle or aircraft to restrain, seat, or position children who weigh 36 kilograms (kg) (80 lb.) or less.” 49 C.F.R. § 571.213.

However, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) interpretations say that products like WhizRider that position the vehicle’s belt to fit the child seated in the seat do not position the child in the seat. Therefore, NHTSA has informed us that the WhizRider does not meet the definition of a Child Restraint System as defined in FMVSS 213.

This letter is being sent to you to inform you that the WhizRider is not a child restraint system or booster seat as defined by FMVSS 213.

This is not a recall notice for your WhizRider.
